## INDIAGovindaswamy

Govindaswamy's execution has been stayed indefinitely.

According to the Campaign Against the Death Penalty in India, on 4 August the Ministry of Home Affairs ordered the Jail Superintendent at Coimbatore Central Prison to defer the execution while they considered his petition for mercy.

## FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/ airmail letters in English or in your own language:

- welcoming the stay of execution;

- calling for Govindaswamy's death sentence to be commuted to a term of life imprisonment;

- expressing unconditional opposition to the death penalty as a violation of the right to life and the right not be subjected to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, and emphasising that the death penalty has never been shown to have a special deterrent effect.
