Amnesty International has learned that the above 10 people, feared to have "disappeared" after being arrested in Waihulae, Viqueque district on 15 November, are now believed to be safe.

According to reports, seven men were arrested on 15 November but all have now been released. Jose da Silva, Francisco da Silva, Gilberto da Silva and Aquiles da Silva were all detained for six days and released on 21 November. Armindo Monteiro, Antonio da Silva Monteiro and Paulo da Costa were all released on 26 November. Four of them have gone into hiding, fearing further harassment by the security forces.

It is not known if they were ill-treated while in custody.

No further action by the UA Network is requested. Many thanks to all UA participants who sent appeals.
