CAMBODIAChao Sambath Nhek Bun Chhay Serey Kosal Por Bun Sreu MP

Amnesty International has learned that Chao Sambath is already dead. The organization believes he was executed in custody. In the light of this news and the killing of Hor Sok earlier this week, concern for the safety of all those in custody following the coup is greatly heightened.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/express/airmail letters in English or French or in your own language:

-expressing deep regret at the killing of Chao Sambath and asking that those responsible are held to account for their actions;
- expressing concern for the safety of General Nhek Bun Chhay, Por Bun Sreu MP and Serey Kosal;
- urging that if they are arrested, their treatment in detention should conform with minimum international standards;
- expressing great regret at the killing of Hor Sok while in custody and urging that those responsible be held accountable for their actions;
- urging that no one should be targeted on account of their peaceful political views.
