Amnesty International is gravely concerned that three close associates of Nhek Bun Chhay may have also been killed. Unconfirmed reports say that the three - Li Seng Hong, Krach Yeuam, Maen Bun Than, were fleeing from Phnom Penh with Chao Sambath, and may have been arrested and killed with him.

The organization is increasingly concerned about the safety of Nhek Bun Chhay, Serey Kosal and Por Bun Sreu and all of those who have been arrested since the coup.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send faxes/telegrams/express/airmail letters in English or French or in your own language:

- asking for information on the whereabouts of Li Seng Hong, Krach Yeuam and Maen Bun Than, and for assurances that if they are in detention, they will not be ill-treated;
- reiterating deep regret at the killing of Chao Sambath and asking that those responsible be brought to justice;
- expressing concern for the safety of General Nhek Bun Chhay, Serey Kosal and Por Bun Sreu MP;
- urging that if they are arrested, their treatment in detention should conform with minimum international standards;
- expressing great regret at the killing of Hor Sok while in custody and urging that those responsible be held accountable for their actions;
- urging that no one should be targeted on account of their peaceful political views.
