Pong Saphai, editor of the newspaper *Nokor Thom*, Sovann Sokha, editor of the newspaper *Antarakhum* and two journalists from *Antarakhum* newspaper all fear for their safety, following the violent coup in Cambodia over the weekend 5-6 July 1997. Both editors are known to have been close to Hor Sok, a senior FUNCINPEC member who was arrested and extrajudicially executed on 7 July.

Pong Saphai is no longer staying at his house in Phnom Penh, as it has already been surrounded once by police loyal to Second Prime Minister Hun Sen. It is believed that this has also happened to the three journalists from *Antarakhum*.

Amnesty International fears for the safety of these four, should they be arrested.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In March 1994, the *Antarakhum* office was attacked by two unidentified men who threw a grenade which exploded and wounded five people, including two newspaper staff. No one was ever brought to justice for the attack.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in English or French or in your own language:

- expressing concern for the safety of Sovann Sokha and journalists at the *Antarakhum* newspaper, and Pong Saphai and journalists at the *Nokor Thom* newspaper;
- urging that they should not be arrested on account of their conscientiously held peaceful political views, or their association with the FUNCINPEC party;
 asking for assurances that journalists and editors will not be targeted for arrest, detention and ill-treatment.

Please continue action for Cheng Sokna and Vutha as outlined in original UA.
