Amnesty International has learned with sadness and regret that Ah Kow was hanged on 5 October 2001. He was sentenced to death in July 1992 for drug trafficking 194.47 grams of heroin. All his appeals for clemency were rejected.

Ah Kow donated the small amount of money he had to the Buddhist Care Centre whose members visited him at Kajang Prison. He left behind a wife and two teenage sons.
