Further Information on UA 287/04 (ASA 31/172/2004, 12 October 2004) Possible "disappearance"/fear for safety

NEPAL Ram Bahadur Parajuli (m), aged 50, street vendor Govinda Raj Rai (m), aged 37, managing director of a magazine

Govinda Raj Rai was released on 12 October. He had not been ill-treated in custody.

There is no further information about Ram Bahadur Parajuli, who was arrested by security forces personnel in plain clothes on 1 October, as he sold cigarettes on the street in Ason Tole, Kathmandu.

Govinda Raj Rai, who is the managing director of the monthly magazine *Asian Star*, was arrested at his home on 7 October. The men who took him away said they needed him for questioning, and would bring him back in a few hours.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send appeals to arrive as quickly as possible, in English or your own language:

- welcoming the release of Govinda Raj Rai;

- expressing concern for the safety of Ram Bahadur Parajuli, arrested on 1 October;

- asking the authorities to reveal where he is held, and give him immediate access to his family, a lawyer of his own choosing, and any medical attention he may need;

- urging them to ensure that he is treated humanely while he remains in custody;

- calling for him to be released immediately and unconditionally unless he is to be charged with a recongnizably criminal offence.
