PAKISTAN Shamu Masih Javed Masih

Although the one-month stay of execution granted to Shamu and Javed Masih by the President of Pakistan expired on 20 August 1997 the two men have not so far been executed. According to jail officials at Hyderabad Central Jail a new date has now been set for 26 August.

Christian groups in Pakistan are continuing to appeal to the President to commute the death sentences.

to all:

- continuing to urge that the death penalty be abolished as it violates the right to life and the prohibition of cruel, inhuman and degrading punishment.
