SINGAPORE Johannes Van Damme, Dutch national, aged 59

Amnesty International has just learned that the Dutch businessman Johannes Van Damme is scheduled to be executed this Friday, 23 September 1994. His only hope now lies with a last minute intervention from President Ong Teng Cheong.

The 59-year-old Dutchman was arrested on 27 September 1991 at Changi Airport and was sentenced to death on 26 April 1993 for trafficking in 4 kilograms of heroin. The Court of Criminal Appeal in Singapore rejected his appeal on 23 November 1993.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams or faxes in English or your own language:

- expressing deep concern that Johannes Van Damme is scheduled to be executed on 23 September 1994;
- urging President Ong Teng Cheong to reconsider his decision and to grant Johannes Van Damme clemency by commuting his death sentence;
- stating Amnesty International's unconditional opposition to the death penalty, and urging that all existing and pending death sentences be commuted.
