UA 331/94 Death Penalty

SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM Nquyen Si Tuan, 23 years old

The People's Court of Ha Noi has sentenced Nguyen Si Tuan to death for drug trafficking. He is a native of the northern province of Lai Chau in Viet Nam, and was arrested on 23 October 1993 in Ha Noi allegedly carrying 2.1 kg of heroin in his rucksack.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In Viet Nam, immediately after a death sentence takes legal effect, the court file is sent to the Chief Justice of the People's Supreme Court and a copy of the judgement is also sent to the Chief Procurator of the Supreme People's Organ of Control for review. Both must decide within two months whether or not to protest the sentence imposed. Within a period of seven days from the time of the death sentence, the convicted person may also submit an appeal for clemency to Viet Nam's President.

In the past, most death sentences have been commuted to jail terms including life imprisonment. The death penalty may be applied as a maximum sentence for around 30 serious criminal offenses including smuggling, treason, espionage, rebellion, murder, rape, defrauding socialist property, and bribery.

Amnesty International opposes the death penalty in all cases on the grounds that it is a violation of the right to life and the right not to be subjected to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

## RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/express and airmail letters either in English or in your own language:

- expressing concern that Nguyen Si Tuan has been sentenced to death;
- stating Amnesty International's unconditional opposition to the death penalty;
- urging that all death sentences, including that of Nguyen Si Tuan, be commuted and that no more death sentences be imposed.
