# UA 15/98 Health concern / Prisoner of Conscience 16 January 1998

# TURKEYHamdi Turanli (also known as Hemre Re o)

Hemre\_ Re\_o, the leader of the Kurdistan Democratic Party/North (KDP/B), was detained in Ankara on 13 January 1998. Amnesty International believes he is a prisoner conscience and is seriously concerned for his health.

Hemre\_ Re\_o was taken into custody from a café. After being held overnight at Ankara Police Headquarters, he was formally arrested by Ankara State Security Court on 14 January and is now held in Ankara Central Closed Prison.

Hemre\_ Re\_o is said to be suffering from cancer of the pancreas for which he underwent surgery three years ago, and also from diabetes and a heart condition. He requires constant medication which may not be being provided by the prison authorities.

Hemre\_ Re\_o left Turkey before the military intervention of March 1971. He has since been living in Germany with his wife and four children and was carrying a German passport when he travelled to Turkey three weeks ago.

The KDP/B, founded in 1992, is an illegal but unarmed political party which is particularly concerned with the problems of Turkey's Kurdish minority.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Although the law forbidding the use of the Kurdish language was abolished in 1991, any assertion of separate Kurdish identity can be punished by up to three years' imprisonment under Article 8 of the Anti-Terror Law. Founding an illegal "separatist" group would be punishable under the Anti-Terror Law, and possibly subject to the death penalty.

# RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in English or your own language:

- appealing for the immediate and unconditional release of Hemre\_ Re\_o (Hamdi Turanl\_) who is imprisoned for his non-violent political activities in breach of Article 10 of the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms, which safeguards freedom of expression;
- expressing concern about Hemre\_ Reso's health, and asking that he be given full access to all necessary medical assistance while in prison.
