TURKEY: Metin Can, lawyer, chairman of Human Rights Association in

Elaz

Dr Hasan Kaya, medical doctor

On 27 February 1993, the bodies of the lawyer Metin Can and his friend, Dr Hasan Kaya, were found by the side of a river under a bridge some 10 kilometres away from the town of Tunceli and 120 kilometres away from Elaz__. Their hands were reportedly bound with wire behind their backs, their shoes were missing, their bodies bore marks of cigarette burns, Hasan Kaya's eyes were gouged out and both had been shot with one bullet in the head. Two cartridges of pistol ammunition were found at the site, but there was no blood on the ground and no mud on their socks.

Both men had "disappeared" together in Elaz_ on 21 February 1993 and were believed to have been abducted after having been called away from Metin Can's home by a telephone call. Subsequently, their families received disturbing telephone calls, the first of which said, "We killed Metin and Hasan. Our condolences!" The telephone calls stopped after a tap was put on Metin Can's telephone. The lawyer's car, in which the two men had departed was found abandoned that same day. The shoes which Metin Can wore on the day he disappeared were found near his house the following Wednesday. He had been chairman of the Human Rights Association (HRA) in Elaz_ since the foundation of the branch and is said to have previously received death threats.

Two autopsies have been carried out on the bodies, the results of which have not yet been released. Metin Can and Dr Hasan Kaya are said to have been killed by torture at around 2 am on Saturday morning, six days after they disappeared. The autopsies reportedly revealed that Metin Can had been strangled and had a rib broken, while Dr Hasan Kaya had a broken tooth and traces of a cord around his neck.

According to reports, tension was high in Elaz__ over the weekend following the discovery of the bodies and the police were occupying strategic points in the city. The funeral of the two murder victims was attended by thousands of mourners.

These killings strongly resemble the abduction, torture and killing of Vedat Ayd_n, board member of the Diyarbak_r branch of the HRA, in July 1991, whose body was found under a bridge some 60 kilometres from Diyarbak_r (see UA 230/91,

EUR 44/92/91, 8 July 1991). There are persistent allegations that the security forces were involved in his killing.

There has been a disturbing increase in the pressure on the HRA in recent weeks: on 18 February the HRA board member in Urfa, Kemal K_l_c, was killed by unknown assassins; on 23 February the HRA representative in Derik, Mehmet Gökalp, was detained and is currently being interrogated, allegedly under torture at Mardin Gendarmerie Headquarters; on 25 February Hac_O_uz, chairman of the Siirt HRA branch, was detained in Siirt; and on 27 February the chairman of the Elaz_HRA branch, Metin Can, was murdered.
