TURKEYMehmet Gün, clerical worker (aged 19)

Mehmet Gün is now known to be held at Diyarbak_r Gendarmerie Command. It was feared that he was at risk of "disappearance", after the authorities did not acknowledge that he was in custody.

His family were told the news of his whereabouts today, after they had again applied to the Diyarbak_r State Security Court prosecutor.

Amnesty International remains concerned that he is at risk of torture.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please continue to send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in English or German:

- urging that Mehmet Gün is not tortured or ill-treated;
- asking to be informed of any charges that may be brought against him;
- reminding the government of Turkey of its obligations under Article 3 of the European Convention of Human Rights, to which Turkey is a state party, which states: "No one shall be subjected to torture or to inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment."
