Amnesty International has just learned of another individual who is being held in incommunicado unacknowledged police custody in Istanbul. Kalender Maden was detained on 6 November 1992 and the organization is concerned for his safety.

Kalender Maden was detained by four plainclothes police officers at noon on 6 November from his greengrocer shop. His detention was witnessed by his wife Nuray. He is said to have been taken away in a white car and is thought to be held at Istanbul Police Headquarters.

Kalender Maden was active in a legal local association, <u>Mahalle Güzelle tirme ve Geli tirme Derne i</u>, whose aim is to improve the environment of their neighbourhood and which had been raided by the police on previous occasions. So far the police

deny holding Kalender Maden and it is feared that he may be subjected to torture during interrogation.

## RECOMMENDED ACTION: Telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters in English or your own language:

- expressing concern that the people named above (including Kalender Maden are being held in incommunicado detention;
- noting that reportedly the police deny holding them;

- urging that their families and lawyers are granted access to them;
- seeking assurances that they are not subjected to any form of ill- treatment or torture while in custody;
- requesting to be informed of any charges brought against them.
