Amnesty International has now learned that the three "disappeared" detainees, Cela Meral, Ziya Ulusoy and Mehmet Üstünda_, were carrying false identity cards when they were detained. Consequently, they were registered under false names. Ziya Ulusoy was registered as Mustafa Erdo_an and Mehmet Üstünda_ as Mustafa Akpolat.

Amnesty International does not know what false name was used by Celal Meral, but it can be assumed that his true identity is known to the police by now. The organization has also been told that all the above detainees have now been registered and may be held for 15 days starting from 8 November 1992.
