According to reports received by Amnesty International, the body of Mehmet Akkum was found on 17 November 1992 dumped in a cemetery in Elaz__ about 140 kilometres from Kur_unlu village. He had been detained on 10 November 1992 together with 70-year-old shepherd Mehmet Akan whose body was found in the fields shortly afterwards. Two witnesses observed them being detained.

Mehmet Akkum's body was mutilated and showed signs of extreme torture: it was slit with a knife on the forearm, burned apparently with a piece of iron and the ears had been cut off.

The other 11 villagers named above remain "disappeared". They are believed to be held in unacknowledged incommunicado detention in Diyarbak_r and there is grave fear for their safety.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters in English or your own language:

- expressing concern that 11 men from Kur_unlu village in the province of Diyarbak_r have been held incommunicado since 12 November 1992 in unacknowledged detention at an unknown place;
- seeking assurances that they are not subjected to torture while in custody;

- calling for an immediate, full and impartial investigation into the reported deaths in detention of Mehmet Akan, aged 70, from Kur_unlu village whose body was found one day after he had been detained on 10 November, and of Mehmet Akkum whose body was found mutilated in Elaz on 17 November;
- requesting to be informed of its findings.
