Dear President Medvedev,

Bulat Chilaev, a 27-year-old driver for the Russian human rights and humanitarian organization Citizens' Assistance, was abducted in April 2006. He was driving to Grozny, Chechnya, when masked men blocked the road. They dragged him out of his car, handcuffed him and drove him away. He has

not been seen since.

On 10 April 2009 his family was informed that the investigation into his disappearance had been suspended. However, the necessary investigative activities had not all been performed before the investigation was suspended.

I urge you to ensure that:

- the case of Bulat Chilaev is effectively and impartially investigated;
- those who are found responsible for his enforced disappearance are brought to justice; and
- witnesses and relatives are provided with protection from intimidation.


