UA 42/98 Death penalty 11 February 1998

BELARUSIhar Mironaw, aged 22

On 23 January 1998, Ihar Mironaw was sentenced to death by the Vitebsk Regional Court. He is thought to be appealing to the Supreme Court of Belarus. If the Supreme Court refuses to uphold his appeal against his death sentence, his only chance will be to appeal to President Lukashenka to grant clemency. Although it is not known how long the process of appeals take it is unlikely any more information will be forthcoming about this case and it will, therefore, be the only possibility to influence the outcome.

Although very little is known about Ihar Mironaw's case he was reportedly found guilty for the murder of a family and charged with premeditated, aggravated murder.

Thar Mironaw is believed to be the first person to be sentenced to death in Belarus this year.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On 22 January President Lukashenka reported that 30 executions had been carried out in Belarus in 1997 and that, since he had come to power in 1994, he had pardoned only one person facing the death penalty.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Russian, English or your own language:

- urging the Supreme Court of Belarus to uphold Ihar Mironaw's appeal against the death sentence passed against him on 23 January 1998;
- asking the Procurator General to protest at the death sentence passed against Ihar Mironaw;
- expressing deep sympathy with the victims of violent crime and their families, but referring to the 1988 Study for the United Nations on the death penalty which concluded that the death penalty was not an effective deterrent for violent crimes;
- expressing concern at the very high rate of executions in Belarus during 1997.
