Of those named above, only Pavel Sheremet remains in detention. The others have all now been released although charges against them remain.

Dmitry Zavadsky was released on 4 September 1997 after having written an appeal for release to the Belorussian President. After his release, however, he reportedly claimed that he had been framed and that his letter had been interpreted as a confession of guilt by the Belorussian authorities. Dmitry Zavadsky has also said that Pavel Sheremet is suffering from bronchitis in detention.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Russian, English or in your own language:

- calling for the immediate and unconditional release of Pavel Sheremet, detained for his professional non-violent activities as a journalist;
- expressing concern at reports that he is ill, and urging that he be granted all necessary medical attention;
- welcoming the releases, but calling for the charges against Dmitry Zavadsky and Yaroslav Ovchinnikov to be dropped, and for the charges against the other four journalists to be dropped if they are simply due to their having sought to exercise their right to freedom of expression.
