Vuk and Danica Draškovi\_ were released from custody on 9 July 1993, after Serbian President Miloševi\_ signed an official presidential pardon. Earlier that same day, the Belgrade Supreme Court had decided to reject an appeal to release the couple filed by a 10-member medical committee which had been examining them recently. The President's pardon overruled this decision: the charges of incitement to riot (see EUR 70/14/93, 7 July 1993) with which both Vuk and Danica Draškovi\_ had been indicted were dropped, but Vuk Draškovi\_ is still charged with assaulting a police officer. It is unclear at present if and when he will be tried.

Because of their poor medical condition, Vuk and Danica Draškovi\_ remain in the Neurological clinic in Belgrade

# FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express and airmail letters in English or your own language:

- welcoming the President's decision to release Vuk and Danica Draškovi\_ from custody;
- urging the authorities to initiate a prompt, independent and impartial inquiry into their ill-treatment and to bring those responsible to justice;
