Giza Criminal Court has confirmed the death sentence in the case of the five people named above, following the approval of the sentence by the *Mufti*, Egypt's highest religious authority.

The five were sentenced to death by hanging for the murder of Khalid Isma'il al-Sayid.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Arabic, English, French or in your own language:

- acknowledging the seriousness of the crime for which the five people were convicted;
- explaining your opposition to the death penalty in all cases as a violation of the right to life, pointing out that it has never been shown to have a unique deterrent effect and is brutalizing to all involved in its application;
- urging Egypt's President to use his constitutional powers to grant clemency and commute these and all other pending death sentences;
- drawing attention to world trends towards abolishing or reducing the use of the death penalty, in accordance with Article 6 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, to which Egypt is a state party;

 reminding the government of Egypt of its commitment to the Universal
- Declaration of Human Rights, which states: "Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person".
