EGYPT: Mohammad al-Sayyid al-Sayyid Higazi

Amnesty International has received reports that Mohammad al-Sayyid al-Sayyid Higazi, a 29-year-old Arabic teacher arrested on 18 August 1991, has been tortured for several weeks at the State Security Intelligence (SSI), Doqqi branch, Cairo, and at the SSI headquarters in Lazoghly. After being detained initially in Doqqi he was reportedly transferred to Tora Istiqbal Prison, but was returned a few days later to the headquarters of the SSI in Lazoghly, where he was allegedly held for two more weeks and tortured. He was then taken back to prison.

Methods of torture are believed to have included electric shocks on sensitive parts of the body and hanging him by his wrists for long periods of time. A representative of the Egyptian Organization for Human Rights is reported to have visited Mohammad al-Sayyid al-Sayyid Higazi in prison and observed the marks of torture on his body.

Mohammad al-Sayyid al-Sayyid Higazi is reported to have been questioned only once by officials from the procuracy ($\underline{\text{niyaba}}$ - public prosecutor's office), when he was apparently charged with membership of an illegal organization, $\underline{\text{al-Gama'a al-Islamiyya}}$ (an Islamic group).

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- expressing grave concern at the reported torture of Mohammad al-Sayyid al-Sayyid Higazi, which is a clear violation of the United Nations Convention against Torture and Other Forms of Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment (ratified by Egypt in 1986);
- seeking urgent clarification of measures taken to investigate this report and bring to justice those responsible;
- urging that he be given immediate and regular access to his family, lawyer and to all necessary medical treatment.
