On 11 August 1996 a lawyer and a fieldworker from the Palestinian Society for the Protection of Human Rights and the Environment (LAWE) visited Jneid Prison in Nablus. They were finally allowed to visit four prisoners: Naser Juma', Jamal al-Nabulsi, Mu'ammar Mabrukeh and 'Abd al-Halim Mabrukeh who have been detained without charge since December 1995. All four are believed to have been tortured by the naval police (bahriyya). The detainees gave affidavits and signed papers giving lawyer Hosni Kalboni power of attorney to represent them. However, when they left the prison, the naval police confiscated the legal documents, claiming that their visit was permitted in their capacity as human rights workers, not as lawyers. They stated that the detainees would not be allowed any legal advice.

Concerns about the torture of these detainees and the other hundred held in Jneid Prison have not ceased (see original EXTRA). Detainees are regularly beaten during interrogation and are forced to stand in painful positions for prolonged periods. Mahmud Jumayel died on 31 July in hospital after being tortured by the naval police in the prison.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Arabic/English or in your own language:

- calling for the immediate release of Naser Juma', Jamal al-Nabulsi, Mu'ammar Mabrukeh and 'Abd al-Halim Mabrukeh who have been detained for eight months without charge or trial, unless they are to be charged with recognizably criminal offences and given a fair trial;
- expressing concern that they have not been given access to a lawyer and that their lawyer's papers were confiscated following a visit on 11 August;
- calling for the torture in Jneid Prison to be stopped and for those responsible to be brought to justice.
