BACKGROUND INFORMATION

No criminal charges are filed against people in administrative detention, and there is no intention of bringing them to trial. Each administrative detention order specifies the date until which the detainee is to be held, but the order is frequently renewed when or before it expires. This process can be continued indefinitely. Hundreds of Palestinians have had administrative detention orders served on them in the past few weeks.
