Wajih Ahmad 'Arman was released without charge on 22 August. The other seven men named above are still in custody.

Iyad Hamadneh, Hani Rawabjeh and 'Ala Shuli are reportedly held incommunicado in the Preventive Security Service (PSS) detention centre in Baytunia.

Fallah Taher Nada, 'Ala Rimawi and Maher 'Awdeh are detained in Junayd prison. They were reportedly out of interrogation on 18 August. A lawyer was allowed to visit them two days later. On 26 August their families tried to visit them, but only children under 10 were allowed in.

Wajih Ahmad 'Arman and the other seven were among a dozen Islamists arrested in the West Bank in mid-July. Some were allegedly tortured or ill-treated on arrest and in custody.

Many thanks to all those who sent appeals on behalf of Wajih Ahmad 'Arman. Please continue to send appeals on behalf of the remaining seven detainees.

## FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Arabic, English or your own language:

- seeking assurances that Nayef Hamadneh, Iyad Hamadneh, Hani Rawabjeh and 'Ala Shuli will not be tortured or ill-treated in detention;
- calling for the seven remaining detainees to be released immediately if they are not to be promptly charged with recognizably criminal offences and tried according to international standards for fair trial;
- asking that they are all given immediate and continuing access to their families and their lawyers;
- calling for an end to the use of incommunicado detention by all branches of the Palestinian security forces.
