Invitation: Report launch on abuse of migrant workers ahead of Qatar World Cup

Amnesty International will hold an **embargoed** press conference in Doha, Qatar on Sunday 17 November at 16:30 local time, ahead of the launch its report *The Dark Side of Migration: Spotlight on Qatar's construction sector ahead of the World Cup.*

The report details the scale of exploitation suffered by migrant workers in Qatar's construction sector - including those employed on multi-million dollar projects run by Qatari and international companies.

The press conference will be held under strict embargo, ending at 00:01 Doha time Monday 18 November (21:01 GMT Sunday 17 November).

A senior delegation from Amnesty International, headed by the Secretary General, Salil Shetty, will be visiting the country to launch the report. Spokespeople will be available for pre-recorded interviews and live interviews on Monday in Doha and London. The Secretary General will be available for interviews in Doha on Sunday.
