SYRIA:Eli Swed, Selim Swed

Amnesty International has learned that Eli and Selim Swed were sentenced on 21 May 1991 to six and a half years' imprisonment. According to the reports received, the final hearing of their trial was held <u>in camera</u> and lasted only a few minutes; neither the defendants nor their lawyer were allowed to speak. As far as Amnesty International is aware, no charges have ever been made public by the authorities, although earlier reports indicated that the two were being tried on charges of espionage or treason. No other details of the trial proceedings or the verdict are known to Amnesty International.

Eli and Selim Swed, members of the Syrian Jewish community, were arrested in November and December 1987 respectively, and held incommunicado for almost two years. Their families were first allowed to visit them in 'Adra Civil Prison near Damascus in October 1989. Their trial is reported to have begun in November 1990 and to have been adjourned on several occasions. One session is reported to have taken place in camera on 5 March 1991.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Telegrams/telexes/airmail letters:

- seeking confirmation of reports that Eli and Selim Swed were sentenced on 21 May to six and a half years' imprisonment;

- expressing concern at reports that the trial sessions were held <u>in camera</u>, and that the charges against the defendants have never been made public;

- requesting details of the charges on which they have been convicted and the legislation on which the charges were based, as well as details of the trial proceedings and of any right of appeal to a higher tribunal;

- seeking assurances that Eli and Selim Swed are being treated humanely, in accordance with internationally recognized standards for the treatment of all prisoners.
