Amnesty International has received information that the hunger-strike of 34 prisoners, including prisoners of conscience, at Oukacha Prison in protest against ill-treatment and removal of personal possessions has now ended. The 25 Islamists, sentenced between 1984 and 1986, ended their hunger-strike on 19 December 1991. The nine others, sentenced for membership of a Marxist group in 1986, finished the hunger-strike on 26 December after the prison governor had agreed to allow them newspapers and return the personal possessions, including radios and heaters, which had been seized from them. Their demand that those responsible for beating and ill-treating them be brought to justice appears not to have been granted.

Two of the prisoners, Mohamed Boukili and Abdel Moumen Chbari, who both fell into a coma during the hunger-strike are now in the Avicennes Hospital, Casablanca. A number of the prisoners are still suffering from the effects of the beatings; among them Brahim Ait Belaid's hand is said to be injured.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Telegrams/telexes/airmail letters (if possible in French or Arabic):

- welcoming the end of the hunger-strike;

- urging the Moroccan Government to ensure that those involved in ill-treatment of prisoners be brought to justice.
