TUNISIA: Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem

Amnesty International has learned that Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem was transferred from Gabes Police Station to the Civil Prison in Gabes, and is no longer being held incommunicado in *garde* \dot{a} *vue* detention. His trial which was to be held on 8 April 1992 has been postponed to 22 April 1992.

Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem was arrested on 7 February 1992 and held in garde \dot{a} vue detention in Gabes Police Station beyond the maximum 10-day period allowed by Tunisian law. Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem suffers from detached retina which could result in blindness should he not receive immediate medical attention.

Amnesty International is concerned that Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem was tortured while being held incommunicado in *garde à vue* detention.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters

- urging that Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem receive all necessary medical care and stress that his eye condition will drastically deteriorate should he not receive the necessary treatment;

- expressing concern that he was held in illegal garde \dot{a} vue detention for longer than the 10-day maximum allowed by Tunisian law.

- expressing concern that he was allegedly tortured while being held in garde \dot{a} vue detention;

- calling upon the Tunisian Government to investigate these allegations of torture immediately, even if no formal complaint has been lodged, and bring to justice those found responsible;

- urging that if the allegations are proved the Tunisian Government should provide Ezzedine Hadj Belgacem with compensation;
