TUNISIATaoufik CHAIEB, 45, teacher

Prisoner of conscience Taoufik Chaieb has now been on hunger strike for 51 days. Amnesty International is very concerned at this situation, and is urging that he be released unconditionally into the care of an independent medical team.

After 40 days on hunger strike prisoners risk permanent damage to their health, though they may live another few weeks after this turning point. While the striker's mental faculties can remain sharp, a number of physical problems may arise, including loss of hearing, deteriorating eyesight and kidney problems. After 51 days on hunger strike, Taoufik Chaieb is at increasingly serious risk of irreversible damage to his health and of death.

According to his wife, who visited him on 25 August, Taoufik Chaieb could not move, was hardly able to keep his eyes open and spoke with difficulty. He has said that he will continue his hunger-strike until his demands are met.

Taoufik Chaieb is in solitary confinement in prison in Tunis, where conditions have been made even worse by a heat wave, with temperatures of over 40°C.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/airmail letters in Arabic, French, English or your own language:

- expressing concern about the health of prisoner of conscience Taoufik Chaieb;
- calling for him to be placed under constant medical surveillance;
- calling for him to be immediately and unconditionally released.
