# Further Information on UA 209/03 (MDE 30/018/2003, 11 July 2003) Fear of torture / incommunicado detention

#### TUNISIA Mohammed ben Hedi Naouar (m), aged 37

Mohammed ben Hedi Naouar was released from detention without charge at 2pm on 16 July. Earlier on the same day he had been brought before an examining judge in Tunis where he was reportedly questioned about his links with Amnesty International, and his relationship with his cousin, Belgacem Naouar, who has been in detention since April 2002, in connection with the explosion of a truck outside a synagogue in Djerba that killed 21 people.

According to information received by Amnesty International, Mohammed ben Hedi Naouar was transferred to Medenine, southern Tunisia, for one night following his arrest on 5 July. The next day he was taken to the Ministry of the Interior in Tunis where he was held until the morning of 12 July. He was then transferred to *Gorjani* detention centre in Tunis. According to his lawyer the arrest date was falsified on the police records, indicating that he had been arrested on 12 July, one week after his actual arrest.

His brother thanked Amnesty International on his behalf for the fast and effective action on this case.

## Many thanks to all who sent appeals. Please send a final round of appeals in Arabic, French, English or your own language:

- expressing concern that Mohammed ben Hedi Naouar was held in secret detention for several days and that his arrest date was allegedly falsified on the police records;

- requesting the authorities to investigate why safeguards against secret detention, as stipulated in Tunisian law, were not respected;

- asking that Mohammed ben Hedi Naouar will not be subjected to further arbitrary arrest or harassment by the security forces.
