TUNISIAKhemais CHAMMARI, human rights activist, parliamentarian

Khemais Chammari was tried and sentenced to five years' imprisonment on 17 July 1996. An Amnesty International observer attended the trial, in which Khemais Chammari was accused of "disclosing a national secret to a foreign power", a charge which he denies. The information he is accused of having disclosed relates to the judicial inquiry in the case of Mohamed Mouadda, President of the Mouvement des Démocrates Socialistes (MDS), Social Democratic Movement, which Khemais Chammari represents in the Tunisian Parliament. Earlier this year Mohamed Mouadda was sentenced to 11 years" imprisonment on charges of secret relations with a foreign power (see follow-ups to EXTRA 118/95).

Amnesty International considers Khemais Chammari a prisoner of conscience and calls for his immediate and unconditional release.

At the end of June, the Secretary General of Amnesty International, Pierre Sané, visited Tunisia and asked to visit Khemais Chammari and other prisoners of conscience, but his request was refused by the Tunisian Government.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express/ airmail letters in French, Arabic, English or in your own language: - condemning the five-year prison sentence passed by the court against Khemais Chammari and reiterating calls for his immediate and unconditional release.
