On 11 December 1996, Najib El Baccouchi stopped his hunger-strike, which he had begun on 13 November to protest against his imprisonment on a charge of racism, which he denies. During his hunger-strike he was beaten and ill-treated and denied access to his family and lawyers (see previous update, MDE 30/42/96, 9 December 1996). He has now been visited by his family.

On 27 November his case was reviewed by the Cassation Court which confirmed his conviction and sentence. All legal venues for appeal have now been exhausted.

Najib El Baccouchi has condemned racism as contrary to his beliefs and to his long-standing political commitment with UGET, the student union (see previous UAs).

After studying his dossier, Amnesty International has concluded that Najib El Baccouchi is being imprisoned solely for his peaceful political beliefs.

PLEASE CONTINUE to send faxes/express/airmail letters in French, Arabic, English or in your own language:

- calling for a full, independent and impartial investigation to be promptly carried out into allegations that Najib El-Baccouchi was beaten and ill-treated whilst on hunger-strike, and that the findings of the investigation be made public;
- continuing to call for the immediate and unconditional release of Najib ${\tt El}$ Baccouchi as a prisoner of conscience.
