AMNESTY EXPERT AVAILABLE FOR INTERVIEWS IN HAITI

Amnesty International's expert on Haiti, Gerardo Ducos, will be in Haiti between 8 and 22 January 2011.

As part of the visit, Ducos will launch the report *Aftershocks: Women speak out against sexual violence in Haiti's camps*, at a press conference on Tuesday 11 January in Port-au-Prince.

The report, which features the stories of over 50 survivors of sexual abuse, looks at the continuing failure to protect girls and women living in makeshift camps from the risk of rape and sexual assault.

Survivors of sexual violence, who are already struggling to overcome the trauma suffered after losing their loved ones, their homes and livelihoods after the earthquake, have no access to medical care and have little hope to see their attackers brought to a court.
