PRESS CONFERENCE INVITATION Kenya: Crackdown on "terrorism" violating human rights

Amnesty International will present a report spelling out how recent "anti-terrorism" operations in Kenya have resulted in serious human rights violations at a press conference in Nairobi on 23 March.

The report, *Kenya: The impact of "anti-terrorism" operations on human rights*, will identify the main human rights violations committed in the context of the investigations of attacks on civilians, including incommunicado detention, detention without charge, torture and ill-treatment and harassment of family members.
