Mass arrests before Madrid Peace Talks

More than 200 people are reported to have been arrested in Egypt during the last few days in connection with their criticism of the Madrid peace talks scheduled to begin on 30 October.

Amnesty International has already received the names of more than 60 people reportedly arrested in all parts of the country. Most are alleged members and sympathizers of the Muslim Brothers. Some were reportedly arrested in connection with the preparation of leaflets or posters and may face charges, others are held in administrative detention (without charge or trial), apparently incommunicado. Amnesty International believes they may be held for the non-violent expression of their conscientiously held beliefs, and is concerned that they are at risk of torture.
