Further information on UA 110/92 (AFR 47/10/92, 2 April 1992) - Legal Concern

Rwanda: Fidèle Kanyabugoyi - Director at the Ministry of Public Works and member of a human rights groups known as KANYARWANDA (Association pour la Promotion de l'Union pour la Justice Sociale)

Amnesty International has just learned of the provisional release of Fidèle Kanyabugoyi on 3 April 1992. He had been arrested on 29 March 1992 by members of the Security police and charged with endangering the security of the state (*atteinte à la surêté de l'Etat*).

Fidèle Kanyabugoyi has had restrictions imposed on his movements. He is not allowed to move outside a radius of 20km from the capital, Kigali, and remains under provisional release pending trial for which no date is known to have been set.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters, in FRENCH if possible:

- welcoming the release of Fidèle Kanyabugoyi but expressing concern that restrictions continue to be imposed on his movements;
- expressing concern that the restrictions have been imposed on him because of his concern on behalf of human rights victims in his country;
- urging the authorities to drop the charge of endangering the security of the state, which is pending against him, and asking for all restrictions imposed on him to be lifted immediately.
