CHILE Carmen Soria and her family

After receiving death threats in October 1998, Carmen Soria and her family have left Chile for a place of safety.

Amnesty International suspected that the threats were a result of Carmen Soria's public campaign to bring to justice those responsible for the murder of her father, the United Nations official Carmelo Soria, in Chile, in July 1976.

She is hoping to return, with her family, to the country shortly.
