COLOMBIA: Juan Alberto GARAY teacher - killed

Amnesty International has received information from the Colombian Presidential Adviser on Human Rights concerning official investigations into the killing of Juan Alberto Garay and the death threats against David Flórez González, José Angel Lasso Sierra, Urbano Barreto Arenas and Enrique Pertuz.

Teacher Juan Alberto Garay's body was found on 2 October 1991, showing signs of torture and gunshot wounds, in the municipality of Umbría, Risaralda department. According to the information received, the preliminary investigation has been initiated by the Criminal Instruction Court 16, <u>Juzgado</u> 16 de Instrucción Criminal of Belén de Umbría. As yet, no one has been charged.

According to the Presidential Adviser on Human Rights, the death threats against David Flórez González, General Secretary of the teachers' union of Santander department <u>Sindicato de Educadores del Santander (SES)</u>; and against José Angel Lasso Sierra, President of the teachers' union of Arauca department <u>Asociación</u> <u>de Educadores de Arauca, (ASEDAR)</u> and ASEDAR officials Urbano Barreto Arenas and Enrique Pertuz, are being investigated by Criminal Instruction Court 11 of Arauca <u>Juzgado 11 de Instrucción Criminal</u>.

While Amnesty International welcomes these investigations, there is concern that although many such investigations are opened in Colombia, only exceptionally do they lead to the identification and prosecution of those responsible for the human rights violation.

According to figures released by the national teachers union <u>Federación</u> <u>Colombiana de Educadores (FECODE)</u>, Colombian Federation of Teachers, 53 teachers were killed in Colombia in 1991 and approximately 250 received threats. FECODE expressed the concern that all investigations into killings of and threats against these teachers have been closed in the courts without convictions.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters

continuing to express concern at the killing of Juan Alberto Garay.
welcoming the official investigation into the killing and urging that it be thorough and impartial and that the results be made public;

- welcoming the investigation into the death threats against David Flórez González, José Angel Lasso Sierra, Urbano Barreto Arenas and Enrique Pertuz and urging that this investigation also be thorough and impartial and the results made public; - urging the authorities again to take all possible measures to protect the lives of teachers and those working for teaching unions to ensure that they can carry out their lawful activities without threat to their physical integrity.
