## MEXICOAt least 120 Tzotzil Indians in the municipality of Chenalhó, Chiapas State

At least 120 Tzotzil Indians from the community of Canolal, municipality of Chenalhó, Chiapas State, have fled their homes as a result of continued harassment, including death threats, by members of armed paramilitary groups for their unwillingness to support the *Partido Revolucionario Institucional* (PRI), Institutional Revolutionary Party, the ruling party.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

More than 8,000 indigenous people in Chenalhó have been displaced in recent months due to the increasingly violent activities of paramilitary groups in the region. On 22 December 1997, 45 displaced Tzotzil Indians, including 21 women and 15 children, were massacred in Acteal, Chenalhó, by paramilitary groups (see UA 409/97, AMR 41/117/97, 23 December 1997 and follow-ups AMR 41/01/97, 2 January 1998; AMR 41/03/98, 14 January 1998).

Although 51 people have been charged with participating in the massacre, including the then mayor of Chenalhó, the judicial authorities have so far failed to investigate the activities of paramilitary groups operating in the region.

# FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or your own language:

- urging that immediate measures be taken to guarantee the safe return of 120 Tzotzil Indians to the community of Canolal, municipality of Chenalhó, Chiapas State;
- calling for a prompt and immediate investigation into reports of threats and intimidation by paramilitary groups against Tzotzil Indians in the municipality of Chenalhó;
- expressing deep alarm at the continuing level of human rights violations in the municipality of Chenalhó;
- calling on the judicial authorities to investigate reports of violent threats and intimidation by members of paramilitary groups operating in northern Chiapas.
