UA 37/00 Fear for safety / Death threat 15 February 2000

On 9 February 2000 an anonymous caller rang the offices of the human rights organization named above and threatened its members with death. Amnesty International is very concerned for their safety.

The caller said: "dejen de estar chingando la madre o se los va a llevar la verga a todos", "stop fucking with things or you are all going to get it". CEFPRODHAC, a non-governmental (NGO) organization based in Reynosa, Tamaulipas State, campaigns against human rights violations in the state.

On 27 January a recently killed eagle which had had its neck broken was left outside CEFPRODHAC offices. Arturo Solís, the director of the organization, believes this was meant as a sinister warning to him and other members of the organization, as a result of their work.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Human rights defenders in Mexico are often intimidated and harassed. In recent years Amnesty International has received many reports of human rights workers being threatened with death, coming under armed attack and being arbitrarily detained. Investigations by the authorities into these crimes rarely results in those responsible being brought to justice.

In recent months the Mexico city-based NGO, Centro de Derechos Humanos "Miguel Augustin Pro Juarez" (PRODH), the Miguel Augustin pro Juarez Centre for Human Rights and its lawyer Digna Ochoa have been the target of sustained death threats. The persistence and gravity of the threats resulted in the Inter-American Court on Human Rights issuing a resolution in November 1999 requesting Mexico take all necessary measures to protect the safety of PRODH staff and bring those responsible to justice.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/faxes/express/airmail letters in Spanish or your own language:

- expressing concern for the safety of Arturo Solís and other members of CEFPRODHAC after its members were threatened with death by an anonymous caller on 9 February 2000;
- calling on the authorities to take all steps, agreed to by those at risk, to guarantee their safety;
- asking the authorities to carry out a full, prompt and impartial investigation into the threats, to make the results public and to bring all those responsible to justice.
