The threats against the community activists named above are reported to have ceased. In letters received by UA participants from the governmental *Comisión Nacional de Derechos Humanos* (CNDH), National Human Rights Commission, the Mexican authorities say they have closed investigations because the threats were anonymous, the standard official response in such a situation.

Amnesty International continues to seek an investigation into the killing of Hector Luis Romo Garduño as part of the organization's campaigning to end the impunity enjoyed by perpetrators of human rights violations in Mexico. However, no further action by the Urgent Action Network is required on this case. Thank you to all who sent appeals.
