PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINAZeng Jingmu, Roman Catholic Bishop, aged 77

According to reports received by Amnesty International, Bishop Zeng Jingmu of Yujiang, Jiangxi province, was released from his place of detention into house arrest on Saturday, 9 May. He is said to be extremely sick but no further details of his health are available at present. He is reported to be restricted to his home and only permitted visits from close relatives.

Zeng Jingmu was serving a three year term of "reeducation through labour", imposed without charge or trial, which is due to expire on 22 November 1998.

Amnesty International welcomes the humanitarian gesture of releasing such an elderly man from custody, but is concerned that his sentence does not appear to have been cancelled. The organization is also concerned at reports of his extremely poor health and seeks assurance from the Chinese authorities that despite being at home he will have access to adequate medical facilities.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/express/ airmail letters in English or Chinese or in your own language:

- welcoming Zeng Jingmu's release from detention as a humanitarian gesture, but demanding that his release be made unconditional and that he be permitted freedom of movement and association;
- seek assurance that he will have access to all necessary medical facilities.
