Amnesty International has learned that Li Seng Hong and Maen Bun Than have been killed. Serey Kosal is now in a safe place. The whereabouts of Nhek Bun Chhay and Chea Chhut are not known and Amnesty International remains concerned for their safety.

Please continue appeals as specified in ASA 23/22/97, expressing grave concern at the killing of Hor Sok, Chau Sambath, Krach Yeum, Sam Norin, Li Seng Hong, and Maen Bun Than; and expressing concern for the safety of Nhek Bun Chhay and Chea Chhut.
