THAILAND Maung Kyan, Mon refugee, early 30s

Amnesty International has learned that the authorities have agreed to move Maung Kyan and his family from the Immigration Detention Centre in Bangkok to the Maneeloy Student Safe Area in Ratchaburi province, apparently on 6 July 1995. The organization greatly welcomes this news as it means that Maung Kyan will be able to receive the medical care he needs.

Amnesty International has been told that the Prime Minister's Office has personally intervened in this case after receiving many appeals from around the world.

Many thanks to all those who sent appeals on behalf of Maung Kyan and his family. No further action by the Urgent Action Network is requested.
