TURKEYNecati Ayd\_n, former President of Health Workers' Union, Diyarbak\_r Branch, aged 30 Mehmet Ay, aged 21

On 9 April 1994, three bodies were found in a field 40 kilometres outside Diyarbak\_r. Two of the dead were identified the same day by relatives as Necati Ayd n and Mehmet Ay. The identity of the third body has not been established.

Necati Ayd\_n and Mehmet Ay had "disappeared" after being detained on 18 March by the Anti-Terror Branch of Diyarbak\_r Police. They were last seen alive in the State Security Court in Diyarbak\_r on 4 April when they were brought before the prosecutor there. On this occasion they were seen by several people including the lawyer Sezgin Tanr\_kulu. The prosecutor demanded that they should remain in custody, but the interrogating judge ordered their release. The prosecutor lodged an objection to this decision with State Security Court No. 3, which was rejected. However, the detainees were not released but presumably brought out by the back door of the court building and taken to an unknown destination. Their relatives waited for them in vain outside the court until late that evening.

On 5 April the families applied to the prosecutor for information as to the whereabouts of their relatives. He told them that the detainees had been released, denying that they had been rearrested, and suggested that they apply elsewhere for information. The Emergency Region Governor and other authorities likewise denied that the two men had been rearrested.

The three bodies, buried side by side about one metre deep, were found on 9 April by villagers working in a field near the village of Ka\_tl\_. The bodies were bruised and had been killed by a bullet in the head. They bodies were clothed and had been recently buried, as the wounds they bore were still bleeding. A ring was found in the pocket of one of the dead which carried the name of Necati Ayd\_n's wife. The villagers notified the Ka\_tl\_ Gendarmerie Post nearby. The prosecutor from Bismil came and examined the bodies which were then taken to Diyarbak\_r State Hospital, after the clothes and other items had been removed.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The arrests originally took place on the 18 March in the house of Necati Ayd\_n's elder brother Hafif in Diyarbak\_r. Hafif Ayd\_n was also detained as were his wife Hüsniye, their children Hilal (17), Meral (16), Velat (15), Berfin (8) and Evin (6). Necati Ayd\_n's wife, Süheyla, and their children, Deniz and Yasemin, were also detained. After four days, all but Necati Ayd\_n, his daughter Yasemin and Mehmet Ay were released. Their detention by the Anti-Terror Branch of Diyarbak\_r Police Headquarters was confirmed by the prosecutor at the State Security Court in Diyarbak\_r on 25 March. On 29 March Yasemin Ayd\_n was released.

FURTHER RECOMMENDED ACTION: Please send telegrams/telexes/faxes/express and airmail letters in English or your own language:

- expressing deep concern about the murder of Necati Ayd\_n, Mehmet Ay and an unidentified third man whose bodies were found on 9 April, after Necati Ayd\_n and Mehmet Ay "disappeared" in detention in Diyarbak\_r, having last been seen in the State Security Court there on 4 April;

- demanding that every step possible is undertaken without delay to find those responsible for this triple murder and to bring them to justice;

- urging that the identity of the third victim be established as soon as possible;
- requesting to be informed of his identity and of the results of the murder investigation;

- calling for urgent measures to stem the alarming increase in "disappearances" and extrajudicial executions.
