- expressing grave concern for the safety of Muhterem Ayato, Mirza Ate_ and Kudusi Ad_güzel, all from _nkaya village near Kulp, who "disappeared" following their detention on 9 February (Muhterem Ayato) and 15 March (Mirza Ate_ and Kudusi Ad güzel);
- urging that immediate steps be taken to establish their whereabouts;
- asking that urgent measures be taken to stem the serious increase in recent cases of "disappearance" in the provinces under Emergency Legislation.
