Of those detained from Ç_narönü village on 11 November, Mehmet Ali Yüksel, ehmus Yeter (possibly Yatak), Abdullah Baran, Ahmet Yavuz, and Mahmut Çakmak (new name) were arrested on charges of supporting the PKK and committed to Mardin Prison, where they are now held. It is not clear how long they were held in custody, but according to reports, they have confirmed that they were tortured while being interrogated by the gendarmes. Other detainees appear to have been released, but this is difficult to establish as the inhabitants of the village are dispersed over a wide area. Some of the 19 households who were burned out of their homes have migrated to Bismil and Diyarbak_r. Some report that they lost money and jewellery when the security forces searched their homes.

An attempt to examine the situation on the ground was made by Hüseyin Y_ld_z, parliamentary deputy for the Welfare Party in Mardin, and a member of the Parliamentary Commission on Migration who came to Mardin on 29 November. He apparently abandoned his attempt to reach the village after he was told by the Governor and Chief of Police of Mardin that Ç_narönü was deserted. Amnesty International's information suggests that most of the houses are still inhabited.

We will seek further information and update the network. No more appeals at this stage. Thanks to all who took action.
