Amnesty International has learned that Oleg Pyatnicky's death sentence has been commuted. In a letter to the Swiss organization "Action of Christians for the Abolition of Torture" President Lennart Meri stated that he shared the view that the death penalty is a violation of the right not to be subjected to inhuman punishment, as proclaimed in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. He has therefore commuted Oleg Pyatnicky's death sentence to a prison term.
