Sadiq Nikbin and Faridun Hussain Zadah were released on 5 September 2000.

Azad Ahmad, a member of the executive committee of the Iraqi Workers' Communist Party (IWCP), was released on 4 September and returned to his house in the town of Rania. However, he was reportedly rearrested the same day and his whereabouts are now unknown.

- welcoming the release of Sadiq Nikbin and Faridun Hussain Zadah;

- asking why Azad Ahmad was rearrested on 4 September;

- asking where he is detained, and seeking assurances that he is being treated humanely;

- urging that he be immediately released if he was arrested solely for his membership of the IWCP.
